

JURISDICTIONAL WETLANDS WITHIN THE CORRIDOR WERE IDENTIFIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CLEAN WATER ACT OF 1977 (33 CFR SECTION 323.2) WHICH DEFINES

WETLAND ECOSYSTEMS AS:
"... THOSE AREAS THAT ARE INUNDATED OR SATURATED BY SURFACE OR GROUNDWATER AT A FREQUENCY AND DURATION SUFFICIENT TO SUPPORT, AND THAT UNDER NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES DO SUPPORT, A PREVALENCE OF VEGETATION TYPICALLY ADAPTED FOR LIFE IN SATURATED SOIL CONDITIONS. WETLANDS GENERALLY INCLUDE SWAMPS, MARSHES, BOGS AND SIMILAR AREAS."
