



1. HARMAN DITCH - This right is actually diverted at the Fountain Mutual Ditch but a flume in Fountain Creek at this point is used to determine how much water is available for these rights.
2. LAUGHLIN DITCH - Straatmoor Homes plan for augmentation uses 5.616 cfs of original 9.36 cfs 12/31/62 and 1.736 cfs of original 2.17 cfs 12/31/63 to recharge the Kieferfeldt aquifer (Case W-3935 and W-4237). The Gates Land Company changed 1.872 cfs of the 12/31/62 priority and 0.434 cfs of the 12/31/63 priority to wells by decree entered on 12/7/71 (Case No. W-309) in connection with Gate's plan for augmentation.
3. STUBBS & MILLER - 0.915 cfs decreed to a Portland Will still at headgate.
4. CHILCOTT DITCH - Case 804100 transferred the 4.69 cfs 12/31/63 right from the Miller Ditch.
5. OWEN & HALL DITCH - Of the 15.4 cfs for the 12/31/62 right remaining at the original headgate, the Gates Land Company transferred 0.425 cfs to a well and 0.075 cfs was left to the stream. (See W-46 and W-309). The remainder is used by the City of Colorado Springs in a plan of augmentation for wells (See W-4376 dated 7/27/77).
6. TALCOTT AND COTTON DITCH - Case 810486 transferred the 11.75 cfs 3/21/72 right from the Douglass Ditch.
7. IRON & IRVINE DITCH - In case No. W-4580, 2.22 cfs of this right was conditionally transferred to a well and 5.50 cfs was left in Fountain Creek. In case No. W-4580-1781 of May 10, 1979 1.76 cfs of the conditional 2.22 cfs was made absolute and the balance, 0.44 cfs, was left in the stream.
8. TCOF & HARMON DITCH - In Case No. W-4185, the Tcof and Harmon headgate was decreed an alternate point of diversion for 1/2 of the Young and Calaway rights (5.5 cfs, 1893 and 1.0 cfs, 1910) and all of the Harman Reservoir storage right (13 af, 1891). The remaining 1/2 of the Young and Calaway rights are shown diverting at the Wood Valley Ditch.
9. BARNISTER DITCH - This water right was transferred to wells (Case No. W-3307) near the old Barnister-Eder Ditch.
10. In a letter dated 8/29/78 from Bob Jesse, Division 2 Engineer, to Bob Emel, Water Commissioner, District 10, when the "stream is dry between the Pueblo Water and Power Return and the Lincoln Ditch headgate above Pinon Bridge the call of downstream seniors will be considered futile on upstream juniors."
11. BENESECH DITCH - Transferred to wells on the east side of Fountain Creek.
12. M.W. STEELE - Transferred to two wells in the vicinity of the old ditch.
